**Examination Appeal**

Thelma McMullen appeals the determination of the Division of Agency Services (Agency Services) that she did not meet the experience requirement for the promotional examination for Social Worker 2, Corrections (PS3191I), Department of Corrections.

The subject examination was announced with a closing date of July 21, 2016 with specific requirements that had to be met as of the closing date (see attached). It is noted that the examination was cancelled on November 24, 2016, since the appellant, the only applicant, was found ineligible for the examination.

A review of the appellant's application reveals that she possesses a Bachelor's degree and has served provisionally in the subject title from February 2016 to the July 21, 2016 closing date, as a Senior Youth Worker from July 2007 to February 2016, as a Mental Health Counselor from June 2005 to July 2007, and as a Youth Counselor from September 2003 to October 2004. Agency Services found that the appellant met the education requirement and credited her with six months of applicable experience for her provisional service in the subject title. However, it did not credit her with any other applicable experience. Accordingly, Agency Services determined that the appellant lacked six months of applicable experience.

On appeal, the appellant provides clarifying information indicating, among other things, that she is currently performing applicable duties while serving

provisionally in the title under test. Moreover, the appellant contends that she has sufficient experience to qualify her for the examination.

Official personnel records indicate that the appellant continues to serve provisionally in the subject title.

### CONCLUSION

*N.J.A.C.* 4A:4-2.6(a) provides that applicants shall meet all requirements specified in the promotional announcement by the closing date. *N.J.A.C.* 4A:1-1.2(c) provides that a rule may be relaxed for good cause in a particular situation.

In the present matter, the appellant should be admitted to the subject examination. Although the appellant's experience in her various positions does not precisely mirror the required experience, the appellant continues to serve provisionally in the title under test and the examination was cancelled due to a lack of applicants. Thus, since she has accrued an additional 10 months of experience as a provisional, under these circumstances, good cause exists to relax the provisions of *N.J.A.C.* 4A:4-2.6(a) and accept the appellant's provisional experience after the closing date, for eligibility purposes only, and to admit her to the examination.

# ORDER

Therefore, it is ordered that this appeal be granted, the cancellation of the examination be rescinded and the appellant's application be processed for prospective employment opportunities only.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in a judicial forum.

Open to employees in the competitive division who have an aggregate of one year of continuous permanent service as of the closing date in any competitive title and meet the requirements listed below:

Education: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree. You must indicate either possession of a degree or total number of college credits completed to date on your application. (Foreign degrees/ transcripts must be evaluated by a recognized evaluation service.) Failure to do so will result in rejection from the examination process.

Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute, in addition to the required experience indicated below, applicable experience on a year for year basis, with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

Experience: One (1) year of experience in social case work which shall have involved having the responsibility for gathering and analyzing social information from clients, the determination of their needs, and the planning and administering of treatment plans geared to the needs of individual clients.

Note: A Bachelor's degree in Social Work including or supplemented by a supervised field placement accredited by the Council on Social Work Education may be substituted for above stated education and experience requirements. You must specify the type of degree you have on your application. (Foreign degrees/ transcripts must be evaluated by a recognized evaluation service.) You must also indicate the dates and hours worked per week of the field placement on your application. Failure to do so will result in rejection from the examination

Note: Possession of a Master's degree in Social Work from an accredited college or university may be substituted for one (1) year of indicated experience. You must indicate the details of your Master's degree on your application. (Foreign degrees/transcripts must be evaluated by a recognized evaluation service.) Failure to do so will result in rejection from the examination process.

License: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position. The responsibility for ensuring that employees possess the required motor vehicle license, commensurate with the class and type of vehicles they operate, rests with the Appointing Authority.
