FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

In the Matter of James Sorenson, Highway Operations Training and Quality Assurance Specialist (PS3065T), Department of Transportation

Examination Appeal

James Sorenson appeals the determination of the Division of Agency Services (Agency Services) that he was below the minimum requirements in experience for the promotional examination for Highway Operations Training and Quality Assurance Specialist (PS3065T), Department of Transportation.

The examination at issue was announced with specific requirements that had to be met as of the June 21, 2016 closing date (see attached). A total of 14 employees applied for the subject examination and eight were determined eligible. Certifications PS161673, PS170273, and PS170459 were issued and their dispositions were recorded indicating that seven of these eligibles were appointed to the subject title and the other eligible's name was removed from list.

On appeal, the appellant presents that he has over 11 years of experience as a Crew Supervisor of an equipment garage. He explains that in this position he performed similar duties as incumbents in the subject title by performing supervisory duties that included training, coaching, and mentoring staff on the use of equipment that is used in roadway maintenance operations. The appellant states that the Operations Training Unit needs to provide equipment training to all Operations field and garage staff which is why the appointing authority provisionally appointed him to the subject title.

CONCLUSION

N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.6(a) provides that applicants shall meet all requirements specified in the promotional announcement by the closing date. *N.J.A.C.* 4A:1-1.2(c) states that the Civil Service Commission (Commission) may relax a rule for good cause in order to effectuate the purposes of Title 11A, New Jersey Statutes.

Initially, Agency Services correctly determined that the appellant did not meet the required experience as his experience as a Crew Supervisor Mechanics from November 2005 to July 2016 involved the training and development of staff who were involved in the maintenance of equipment used in roadway maintenance, but not primarily involved in roadway maintenance operations. However, a review of the subject announcement indicates that training and developing staff on job equipment familiarization is part of the requirements. Therefore, although the appellant's work experience does not precisely mirror the requirements contained in the announcement, the Commission is satisfied that the totality of Mr. Sorenson's work training staff on the use of roadway maintenance operations equipment since November 2005 as well as his provisional service in the subject title, which began in July 2016, warrants his admission to the subject examination. Further, the list is incomplete as there are no names currently on the eligible list. Therefore, under these circumstances, good cause exists to relax the provisions of N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.6(a) and accept the totality of Mr. Sorenson's experience, including his experience after the closing date, and admit him to the subject examination.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ordered that this appeal be granted and James Sorenson's application be processed for prospective employment opportunities only.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in a judicial forum.

Open to employees in the competitive division who have an aggregate of one year of continuous permanent service as of the closing date in any competitive title and meet the requirements listed below:

Education: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree. You must indicate either possession of a degree or total number of college credits completed to date on your application. (Foreign degrees/ transcripts must be evaluated by a recognized evaluation service.) Failure to do so will result in rejection from the examination process.

Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute, in addition to the required experience indicated below, applicable experience on a year for year basis, with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.
