FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

In the Matter of Lisa Lewis, Program Support Specialist 2 (Assistance Programs) (PS1543K), Department of Children and Families

Lisa Lewis appeals the determination of the Division of Agency Services (Agency Services) that she did not meet the experience requirements for the promotional examination for Program Support Specialist 2 (Assistance Programs) (PS1543K), Department of Children and Families.

The examination at issue was announced with specific requirements that had to be met as of the August 22, 2016 closing date (see attached). A total of nine employees applied and four were deemed eligible. Certification PS170258 was issued containing the names of the four eligibles and another eligible from a prior non-expired list. The four eligibles from the subject list were permanently appointed to the subject title.

CONCLUSION

N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.6(a) provides that applicants shall meet all requirements specified in the promotional announcement by the closing date. N.J.A.C. 4A:1-1.2(c) states that the Civil Service Commission (Commission) may relax a rule for good cause in order to effectuate the purposes of Title 11A, New Jersey Statutes.

Initially, it is noted that Agency Services correctly determined that the appellant was not eligible for the subject examination as she did not meet the education and experience requirements by the August 22, 2016 closing date. Specifically, Agency Services credited her with two years and one month of

experience based on her 63 college credits and three years and seven months of experience based on her provisional service in the subject title from December 2012 to April 2015 and from June 2015 to the August 22, 2016 closing date, but determined that she lacked four months of experience. Any applicable experience the appellant had as a Buyer would be considered out-of-title work and her other experience in purchasing or clerical titles was not applicable. However, the appellant has earned the required experience after the closing date by provisionally serving in the subject title from the August 22, 2016 closing date until February 2017, when she was returned to her permanent title of Buyer. Additionally, there are currently no names on the subject list. Accordingly, good cause exists to accept the appellant's experience after the closing date, for eligibility purposes only, and to admit her to the examination.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ordered that the appeal be granted and Lisa Lewis' application be processed for prospective employment opportunities only.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in a judicial forum.

Open to employees in the competitive division who are currently serving in a title to which the announcement is open and have an aggregate of one year of continuous permanent service as of the closing date in the following title(s):

Program Support Specialist 3 Assistance Programs

Or to employees in the competitive division who have an aggregate of one year of continuous permanent service as of the closing date in any competitive title and meet the requirements listed below:

Education: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree. You must indicate either possession of a degree or total number of college credits completed to date on your application. (Foreign degrees/transcripts must be evaluated by a recognized evaluation service.) Failure to do so will result in rejection from the examination process.

Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated on a year for year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

Experience: Two (2) years of experience in a public or private agency having responsibility for analyzing, monitoring, maintaining or implementing social service, economic assistance, community service, sustenance (food), or any other human support/assistance program.

Note: A Master's degree in Social Work, Psychology, Education, Public Administration, Business Administration or a related field may be substituted for one (1) year of the required experience. You must indicate the details of your Master's degree on your application. (Foreign degrees/transcripts must be evaluated by a recognized evaluation service.) Failure to do so will result in rejection from the examination

License: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position. The responsibility for ensuring that employees possess the required motor vehicle license, commensurate with the class and type of vehicles they operate, rests with the Appointing Authority.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. NJAC 4A:4-2.6 states that all requirements listed, including assignment to the department and unit scope, must be met as of the closing date.

If 35- and 40-hour positions are used within the unit scope, the resulting list may be used to fill either work week position.
