FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

In the Matter of Omar Turner, Institutional Trade Instructor 2, Cooking (PS3485I), Bayside State Prison

Examination Appeal

CSC Docket No. 2017-2588

Omar Turner appeals the determination of the Division of Agency Services (Agency Services) that he was below the minimum requirements in experience for the promotional examination for Institutional Trade Instructor 2, Cooking (PS3485I), Bayside State Prison.

The examination at issue was announced with specific requirements that had to be met as of the September 21, 2016 closing date (see attached). The appellant was the only employee who applied for the subject examination and was deemed ineligible. Therefore, the examination was cancelled due to a lack of qualified candidates.

CONCLUSION

N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.6(a) provides that applicants shall meet all requirements specified in the promotional announcement by the closing date. N.J.A.C. 4A:1-1.2(c) states that the Civil Service Commission (Commission) may relax a rule for good cause in order to effectuate the purposes of Title 11A, New Jersey Statutes.

Initially, Agency Services correctly determined that the appellant did not meet the required experience as he received credit for his four months of provisional service in the subject title from June 2016 to the September 21, 2016 closing date and one year and two months of experience for his service as a Head Cook from November 2003 to December 2004, but determined he lacked one year and six

months of experience. However, as an Institutional Trade Instructor 1, Food Processing from December 2004 to June 2016, the appellant gained experience teaching inmates on the use of institutional food equipment in order to process food. Therefore, although the appellant's work experience does not precisely mirror the requirements contained in the announcement, the Commission is satisfied that the totality of Mr. Turner's work since November 2003, as well as his provisional service in the subject title, which began in June 2016, warrants his admission to the subject examination. Further, the examination has been cancelled due to a lack of qualified applicants. Therefore, under these circumstances, good cause exists to relax the provisions of N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.6(a) and accept the totality of Mr. Turner's experience, including his experience after the closing date, and admit him to the subject examination.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ordered that this appeal be granted, the cancellation of the examination be rescinded and Omar Turner's application be processed for prospective employment opportunities only.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in a judicial forum.

Open to employees in the competitive division who are currently serving in a title to which the announcement is open and have an aggregate of one year of continuous permanent service as of the closing date in the following title(s):

Institutional Trade Instructor 1 Cooking

Or to employees in the competitive division who have an aggregate of one year of continuous permanent service as of the closing date in any competitive title and meet the requirements listed below:

Experience: Three (3) years of experience in the areas of food preparation and processing including but not limited to cooking, baking, meat cutting, pot washing, dishwashing, and the serving of food in a commercial or an institution kitchen.

Note: Your score will reflect credit for formal experience involving or related to cooking. You must indicate the number of people cooked for, the type of food prepared (fast food through institutional cooking) and the level of your responsibility assisting in the preparation through being in charge of the cooking operation, for each position listed in order to receive credit.

License: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position. The responsibility for ensuring that employees possess the required motor vehicle license, commensurate with the class and type of vehicles they operate, rests with the Appointing Authority.
