



## CONCLUSION

*N.J.S.A.* 11A:4-6 and *N.J.A.C.* 4A:4-3.4 provide that an eligible list may be revived in order to implement a court order or decision of the Civil Service Commission in the event of a successful appeal instituted during the life of a list, to correct an administrative error, or for other good cause. *N.J.S.A.* 11A:4-6 and *N.J.A.C.* 4A:4-3.3(b)1 provide that no list shall have a duration of more than four years.

In the present matter, the record establishes that the appointing authority requested and received freeze exemption to fill promotional positions in the titles of Assistant Crew Supervisor Mechanics and Fingerprint Processing Technician 2. However, the subject eligible lists had already expired on December 30, 2018 when the freeze exemptions were received. Therefore, the subject eligible lists could not be certified to effectuate the appointments of McIntosh, Williams and McNeil. Under these circumstances, good cause has been presented to revive the subject eligible lists to allow for a one-time certification from each list.

## ORDER

Therefore, it is ordered that this request be granted and the eligible lists for Assistant Crew Supervisor Mechanics (PS0581P) and Fingerprint Processing Technician 2 (PS0342P), Division of State Police, be revived to allow for one-time certifications.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in a judicial forum
