

CONCLUSION

N.J.S.A. 11A:4-6 and *N.J.A.C.* 4A:4-3.4 provide that an eligible list may be revived in order to implement a court order or decision of the Civil Service Commission in the event of a successful appeal instituted during the life of a list, to correct an administrative error, or for other good cause.


In the present matter, Matuszewicz was provisionally appointed to the title of Master Mechanic with an effective date of March 14, 2020. However, the PS4908P eligible list for Master Mechanic expired on July 5, 2020 and no promotional announcement currently exists for the appointing authority. Moreover, Matuszewicz provisional appointment, predates the expiration of the subject eligible list. The filing of vacancies through permanent appointment from an active eligible list is preferable and more expedient than announcing a new examination. Accordingly, good cause has been presented to revive and extend the Master Mechanic (PS4908P) eligible list so that a certification may be issued to allow for Matuszewicz's regular appointment to the title of Master Mechanic.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ordered that this request be granted and the eligible list for Master Mechanic (PS4908P), Division of State Police be revived and a certification issued to allow John Matuszewicz to receive a regular appointment.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in a judicial forum.
