ISSUED: JANUARY 21, 2022 (ABR)

V.L., represented by Albert J. Seibert, Esq., requests permission to submit a late application for the promotional examination for Police Sergeant (PM4619C), City of Paterson (Paterson).

By way of background, the subject examination was announced on October 1, 2021 with an application filing deadline of October 21, 2021 and all applications had to be received by 4:00 p.m. on that date. It is noted that the petitioner has been conditionally admitted to the subject examination, which has not yet been administered.

In support of his application, the petitioner submits a sworn, notarized statement that he was unable to complete an application for the subject examination by the application deadline because of personal circumstances. Specifically, he submits that he is the primary caretaker for his mother, who has a disability, having had two brain surgeries. He states that on October 10, 2021, his mother experienced a significant adverse reaction to her second COVID-19 vaccination dose which required him to care for her around the clock. Additionally, on or about the same date, another member of his immediate family tested positive for COVID-19 and experienced symptoms which required his attention. Furthermore, heavy rainfall around this period flooded his basement and home, requiring him and his family to temporarily vacate the premises. Moreover, he states that because the vast majority of his workday is spent on the road and his office in the Paterson Police Department is located in a relatively secluded portion of his workplace, he did not see a notice about the examination announcement.

### CONCLUSION

*N.J.A.C.* 4A:4-2.6(a)4 provides that applicants for promotional examinations shall submit an application on or before the announced application filing date. *N.J.A.C.* 4A:4-2.1(e) states that unless otherwise provided for by the Chairperson or designee, applications for open competitive and promotional examinations shall be submitted to the Civil Service Commission no later than 4:00 P.M. on the announced application filing date. *N.J.A.C.* 4A:1-1.2(c) provides that a rule may be relaxed for good cause shown in a particular situation.

In the instant matter, applications for the subject promotional examination were due by the application filing deadline of October 21, 2021. However, the petitioner has submitted a sworn, notarized statement in which he attests to experiencing significant hardships during the application period, including two family members suffering serious illnesses and flooding in his home. Under these circumstances, good cause exists to relax the provisions of *N.J.A.C.* 4A:4-2.6(a)4 and allow the petitioner to file an application after the application deadline date for the Police Sergeant (PM4619C), Paterson examination.

### ORDER

Therefore, it is ordered that this appeal be granted. It is further ordered that the completed application and required \$50.00 application processing fee should be forwarded to: New Jersey Civil Service Commission, Division of Agency Services, P.O. Box 322, Trenton, New Jersey 08625-0322. The completed application and processing fee must be postmarked no later than 15 days from the issuance date of this decision. Failure to file the application and processing fee within the time provided will result in rejection from the examination process. Finally, upon determination of eligibility, the appellant be admitted to the subject examination

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in a judicial forum.
