


The petitioner was not admitted to the subject examination since he did not complete the filing of an application by 4:00 p.m. on the February 28, 2022, closing date. Nevertheless, the petitioner provided medical documentation indicating that he was hospitalized from January 1, 2022 to March 1, 2022. The Commission generally denies requests to accept late examination applications, as *N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.1(e)* requires applicants to file their applications by the closing date. However, under the circumstances presented, the Commission finds that there is good cause to relax *N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.1(e)* and admit the petitioner to the subject examinations. Finally, as this remedy is limited to the unique circumstances of this matter, it does not provide a precedent in any other matter.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ordered that this request be granted, and the petitioner's applications for Police Officer (M0005D), Bayonne, Police Officer (M0059D), Hoboken, Police Officer (M0066D), Jersey City, Police Officer (M0103D), Newark, Police Officer (M0106D), North Bergen, Police Officer (M0155D), Union City, Sheriff's Officer (C0220D), Hudson County, and State Park Police Officer Trainee (S0231D) be accepted.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in a judicial forum.
