SECTION B – MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS**B-20 THEODORO JUNGREN CSC DOCKET NO. 2020-1871**

Theodoro Junggren appeals the determination of the Division of Agency Services (Agency Services), which found that he did not meet the residency requirement for the open competitive examination for Equipment Operator (C0774A), Union County.

A.P. appeals the removal of his name from the eligible list for Correctional Police Officer (S9988A), Department of Corrections on the bases of falsification of the preemployment application and a positive drug test.

B.B. appeals the removal of his name from the Correctional Police Officer (S9988V), Department of Corrections eligible list on the basis of an unsatisfactory criminal record.

C.M., a former Senior Police Officer, Human Services, with the Department of Human Services (DHS), appeals the determination of the Deputy Commissioner, DHS, which found which found that the appellant did not present sufficient evidence to support a finding that he had been subjected to a violation of the New Jersey State Policy Prohibiting Discrimination in the Workplace (State Policy).

B-25 R.I. CSC DOCKET NO. 2018-2781

R.I., an Auditor 3, Taxation with the Department of the Treasury (Treasury), requests enforcement of the March 2, 2018 determination of the Director, Division of Administration, stating that sufficient evidence was found to support a finding that the appellant was subjected to a violation of the New Jersey State Policy Prohibiting Discrimination in the Workplace (State Policy).
