## New Jersey Civil Service Commission to Host Second Statewide Job Fair in October

**TRENTON, NJ** - The New Jersey Civil Service Commission (CSC) will be hosting another Statewide Job Fair on Thursday, October 26<sup>th</sup> at Essex County College's Cleo Hill, Sr. Physical Education Building in Newark, NJ from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm.

This will be the second statewide job fair hosted by CSC this year. Over 45 state departments, agencies, colleges, and universities will be in attendance to promote their missions, explain their organization's responsibilities, highlight open job positions, promote opportunities for career advancement, and answer any questions the job seekers may have.

Some of the job titles include finance and customer service, nurses, social workers, engineers, medical records clerks, and food service workers.
