**NJ Civil Service Commission Issues 2026 Law Enforcement Examination
Announcements**

TRENTON, NJ – The New Jersey Civil Service Commission (CSC) today issued announcements for Entry-Level Law Enforcement Examination (LEE) titles for several jurisdictions. The LEE assesses applicant readiness for entry into law enforcement titles considered to have common knowledge, skills, abilities, and other characteristics. Examination announcements and applications will be accepted until March 31, 2026.

The 2026 LEE brings some changes to the application process. This year, a pool system will be used; this way, candidates can apply for up to four (4) different law enforcement title areas on one application for a flat application fee of \$70. Once all applications are received and reviewed for eligibility, those who are approved to take the LEE will move on in the process as candidates.

- County Police Officer

- Police Officer, Palisades Interstate Park*
- State Park Police Officer*
- Sheriff's Officer
- County Correctional Police Officer

- Parole Officer Recruit**
- Parole Officer Recruit, Bilingual in Spanish and English**
- Parole Officer Recruit Youth Justice Commission*,**
- Parole Officer Recruit Youth Justice Commission, Bilingual in Spanish and English*,**
