

2025 CPM Graduation Webpage Summary

The theme of the 2025 Certified Public Manager (CPM) graduation ceremony was "**Leading** with Purpose, Serving with Pride"

Six cohorts participated in the 2025 CPM graduation held on September 26, 2025, with a total of 125 graduates. The graduating class consisted of **30 State**, **24 County**, and **71 Local** public sector leaders. The following cohorts were recognized:

- Atlantic City 5
- Freehold 6
- Lawrence Township 2
- NJ3 Virtual
- NJ4 Virtual
- Wayne 6

Graduates represented nine **State departments and agencies**, Agriculture, Children and Families, Environmental Protection, Health, Human Services, Labor and Workforce Development, Transportation, Treasury, and the Civil Service Commission.

A total of 49 local regions were represented, such as: Atlantic City, Borough of Audubon, Cape May, City of Brigantine, City of Passaic, Edison Township, Egg Harbor Township, Fort Lee, Freehold, Galloway Township, Hudson County, Lawrence Township, Maple Shade, Middle Township, Monroe Township, Morristown, Passaic County, Randolph Township, Readington Township, Town of Dover, Township of Little Falls, Township of Montclair, Town of West New York, Union County, West Long Branch, Winslow Township, and Woodbury.

The CPM Program continues to attract and develop a diverse group of New Jersey's executive-level public leaders, including municipal clerks, business administrators, county clerks, mayors, council members, emergency services personnel, police chiefs, fire captains, human resources managers, managers of public safety, chief financial officers, to deputy directors.

Since the revamp of the NJ CPM Program in 2012, **1,295 public sector professionals from 70 cohorts** have completed the program.
