IMPORTANT NOTICE TO UEZ BUSINESSES

As of July 1, 2011, the New Jersey Urban Enterprise Zone Program is transitioning the business certification program which allows you to take advantage of the tax benefits to on an on-line system. Until June 30, 2011, please continue to send your annual reports to your Urban Enterprise Zone Coordinators.

After July 1, 2011 through August 31, 2011, you may continue to send your paper forms directly to the Urban Enterprise Zone Program at PO Box 822, 101 South Broad Street, 6th Floor, Trenton, NJ 08625-0822, Attention, Tax Incentive Program, or you may go to the NEW JERSEY BUSINESS ACTION CENTER on-line at:

www.newjerseybusiness.gov

Please look for the new Urban Enterprise Zone Icon on the home page, click on it, and register to file your reports on-line. The on-line program will also afford you the ability to pay your sales taxes, complete applications for new businesses and offer a business friendly way for you to secure and maintain UEZ benefits for your firm.

After September 1, 2011, all businesses should complete their reports on-line. You will use the same process to file your re-certification applications beginning November 1, 2011. Again, please remember to submit your applications at least 60 days prior to your expiration date. During the transition period, your business' program eligibility will not be revoked and we will be flexible in helping you get your reports in as needed to maintain your active participation in the program. In hardship situations we will accept paper filings consistent with procedures used by the Division of Taxation.

The following Zones were granted extensions at the April 13, 2011 meeting of the UEZA so the Zone Businesses can continue to participate in the program during the 16 year extended period. They include East Orange, Guttenberg, Hillside, Irvington, North Bergen, Pemberton, and West New York. All other Zone designations remain in effect.
