Uniform Construction Code

N.J.A.C. 5:23-3.4

Effective Date: September 25, 2023.

Take notice that the Department of Community Affairs (Department) discovered errors in the text at N.J.A.C. 5:23-3.4, Responsibilities. These errors stem from the adoption of the 2018 model codes, which resulted in the criteria for automatic rain sensor devices being moved from the electrical subcode to the plumbing subcode. This notice of administrative correction concerns the incorrect placement for automatic rain sensor devices within the electrical subcode enforcement responsibility table at N.J.A.C. 5:23-3.4(a)3, as well as the incorrect Uniform Construction Code citation for these devices. For accuracy, this notice of administrative correction removes the reference and the associated note for automatic rain sensor devices from the electrical subcode enforcement responsibility table and inserts both into the plumbing subcode table at N.J.A.C 5:23-3.4(a)2. In addition, the reference within the table referencing automatic rain sensing devices at N.J.A.C. 5:23-3.16(c) is changed to state the accurate cross-reference, N.J.A.C. 5:23-3.15(c).

The Department has requested, and the Office of Administrative Law has agreed to, such correction be made administratively. This notice of administrative correction is published pursuant to N.J.A.C. 1:30-2.7.
