This bulletin contains a list of those specific codes, standards and recommended practices referenced in the Informational Notes of the Electrical Subcode (2020 National Electrical Code). This bulletin replaces Bulletin No. 15-2, which has been withdrawn.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:23-3.16(a)2.i., these codes, standards and recommended practices are considered “adopted by reference” to the extent prescribed by each related section(s) of the Electrical Subcode, and may be cited as a requirement (or a violation) of the Uniform Construction Code.

This list is provided for the uniformity of enforcement. It is not an exhaustive list of all the codes, standards and recommended practices referenced in the Informational Notes of the Electrical Subcode, but includes only those codes, standards and recommended practices that the Department of Community Affairs considers necessary for the enforcement of the Electrical Subcode.
