SUMMARY OF RULE CHANGES IN AUGUST 31, 2022 TRANSMITTAL

April 4, 2022, <u>New Jersey Register</u>

<u>N.J.A.C.</u> 5:23-7.19, 7.31, 11.2 and 11.4 – Completely Inclusive Playgrounds (Jake's Law) – This adoption incorporates requirements for the design and construction of completely inclusive playgrounds for the public use with surface, design, and maintenance requirements that are in accordance with the appropriate accessibility standards.

April 18, 2022, *New Jersey Register*

N.J.A.C. 5:23-3.4 – **Responsibilities** – This adoption addresses the assignment of enforcement responsibilities for solar energy systems.

June 6, 2022, New Jersey Register

N.J.A.C. 5:23-2.24, 3.14, 6.26, 6.27, and 8.5 – Notice of Administrative Correction – This Notice of Administrative Correction revises incorrect Section titles, corrects wording, and removes references to a now-dissolved Bureau within the division.
