# SUMMARY OF RULE CHANGES IN APRIL 30, 2022 TRANSMITTAL

October 18, 2021, New Jersey Register

**N.J.A.C. 5:23-6.8 – Mechanical Equipment Sizing –** This adoption specified that Section 312 of the Mechanical subcode and Section M1401.3 of the one- and two-family dwelling subcode only apply when appliance/equipment ratings are increased. It also corrected the equipment guard requirements for the fuel gas materials and methods, consistent with the mechanical materials and methods.

### January 3, 2022, New Jersey Register

**N.J.A.C.** 5:23-4.3D – Notice of Administrative Correction – This Notice of Administrative Correction corrected the location of amendments within the ANSI A119.5, Standard for Park Model Recreational Vehicles for accuracy with the version currently in effect.

### February 7, 2022, New Jersey Register

<u>N.J.A.C.</u> 5:23-3.4, 3.14, 3.21, 6.5, 6.6, and 6.7 – Various Amendments – This adoption corrected oversights in the delineation of responsibilities, corrected terminology used throughout the building subcode, and deleted obsolete cross-references within the one- and two-family dwelling subcode. It also addressed grounding system upgrades during rehabilitation projects.

#### March 7, 2022, New Jersey Register

**N.J.A.C. 5:23** – The Uniform Construction Code was readopted, effective for seven more years. The new expiration date is February 9, 2029.

**N.J.A.C. 5:23-6.26 and 6.27 – Electrical Reconstruction** – This adoption requires that, for reconstruction projects in Group R-2, R-3, R-4, and R-5, the number of electrical receptacles and lighting outlets must be the same as those required for new construction in accordance with the relevant sections of the National Electrical Code.
