Build America, Buy America Act: Buy America Preference (BAP)



PURPOSE: The “Buy America Preference” (BAP) Certification is used to certify that, as required by federal law, materials meet the requirements of the Build America, Buy America Act (BABA) for federally funded infrastructure projects with an aggregate of \$250,000 or more funds, unless an applicable waiver applies and is granted.

REQUIREMENTS: BAP requirements for CDBG-funded projects are implemented in phases based on the CDBG program year in which the project receives funding.

1. FY2023 (SFY2024): All iron and steel used in the project are produced in the United States. This means all manufacturing processes, from the initial melting stage through the application of coatings, occurred in the United States.
2. FY2024 (SFY2025): All iron and steel, and all listed construction materials (non-ferrous metals; lumber; and plastic- and polymer based composite building materials, pipe, and tube) used in the project are produced in the United States.
3. FY2025 (SFY2026) & Forward: All iron and steel, all listed (see above) and not listed construction materials (all other plastic- and polymer-based products, glass, fiber optic cable, optical fiber, engineered wood, and drywall), and all manufactured products, are produced in the United States.

CERTIFICATION: I hereby certify the materials installed/to be installed conform to the Build America, Buy America Provisions. In addition, I understand and agree that the provisions of 31 U.S.C. Chapter 38, Administrative Remedies for False Claims and Statements, apply to this certification and disclosure, if any. Signing this document does not alleviate the signee of providing additional evidence of compliance upon request.
