

Atlantic County Homelessness Consortium (ACHC)
Membership Process

At the last Executive board meeting, the board decided to update the governance charter and written standards, therefore, the process for becoming a member will be revised. At the moment, the eligibility process for Continuum of Care (CoC) membership is open to the public and involves the following steps:

- Application: Interested individuals or organizations submit an application to the CoC lead agency
- Review: The CoC lead, and Monarch representative review the application to ensure it meets eligibility criteria
- Assessment: The lead agency assesses the applicant's alignment with the CoC's mission and goals
- Approval: If the application is approved, the applicant becomes a member of the CoC
- Orientation: New members of the CoC receive the governance charter and written standards via email. The Monarch rep may provide guidance about the CoC's services and activities by virtual orientation.
