

# **Trenton / Mercer CEASe System Map**

## **NOT HOMELESS**

Persons not homeless, but in need of services to prevent homelessness, will be directed to Prevention Services for assistance and will exit the system.

#### **Assessment Locations**

### ASSESSMENT & PRIORITIZATION

- 1. Assessment will determine priority based on level of need and homeless history; Persons with the highest level of need will be housed first.
- 2. Persons will be added to By-Name Lists (BNL) which initiates Housing Stability Planning process.
- 3. Multiple By-Name Lists (Chronic, Non-Chronic, Families, Veterans and Youth.)

## **HOUSING STABILI** PLANNING

- 1. CEASE Coordinated Assessment Team reviews the By-Name Lists assessment scores, and housing needs determined during assessment.
- 2. Team matches the individual, family and youth with the best housing resources available.

## HOUSING NAVIGATION

Individual, families and youth are connected with case management services to complete housing applications, conduct housing search and provide housing support.

#### Youth Assessment

1. Youth will be connected to Youth Coordinated Assessment (Anchor House) within 24 hours.
