

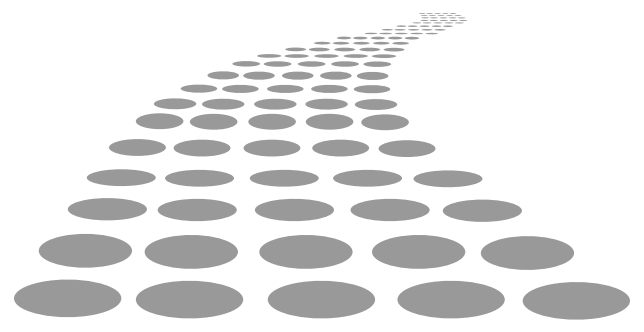
Trenton / Mercer CEASe System Map

SCREENING

Persons seeking or receiving services at the locations below can be screened for homelessness or referred to appropriate agency for screening.

NOT HOMELESS

Persons not homeless, but in need of services to prevent homelessness, will be directed to Prevention Services for assistance and will **exit the system**.

HOMELESS

Persons who are homeless will be directed to assessment locations designated for Singles, Families and Youth.

** Persons with employment history are redirected to RRH provider (CC, HomeFront, MCBOSS) for Assessment.*

** Youth Under age 25 directed to Anchor House Youth Coordinated Assessment within 24 hours.*

** All others will be directed to appropriate locations for assessment after 30 days.*



Assessment Locations

ASSESSMENT & PRIORITIZATION

1. Assessment will determine priority based on level of need and homeless history; Persons with the highest level of need will be housed first.
2. Persons will be added to By-Name Lists (BNL) which initiates Housing Stability Planning process.
3. Multiple By-Name Lists (Chronic, Non-Chronic, Families, Veterans and Youth.)

1. CEAS Center - Unsheltered
2. Rescue Mission - Sheltered
3. MCBOSS - TH/Other
4. HomeFront (1880)
5. Catholic Charities - Outreach
6. Womanspace - DV

Family Assessment

1. MCBOSS
2. HomeFront
3. Catholic Charities
4. CEAS AFS
5. WomanSpace - DV

Youth Assessment

1. Youth will be connected to Youth Coordinated Assessment (Anchor House) within 24 hours.

HOUSING STABILITY PLANNING

1. CEASE Coordinated Assessment Team reviews the By-Name Lists assessment scores, and housing needs determined during assessment.
2. Team matches the individual, family and youth with the best housing resources available.

HOUSING NAVIGATION

Individual, families and youth are connected with case management services to complete housing applications, conduct housing search and provide housing support.



HOUSING

Individuals, families and youth will be connected to appropriate housing type based on assessment.
