## Section

1. Enter your Social Security Number (SSN) and DFSID Number, if issued to you in the space provided. The collection of the SSN is <a href="mailto:mandatory">mandatory</a>, and is collected under authority of N.J.S.A. 54:50-24 et seq. and Administrative Rule N.J.A.C. 5:3-1.2. The mandatory provision requires the collection of your SSN which enables both the Division of Fire Safety within the Department of Community Affairs and the Division of Taxation within the Department of Treasury to conduct more efficiently, the necessary background check before issuance, denial, renewal, suspension or revocation of a certification.

Please note the required information we require to create your certification in our computer system, designated with an asterisk (\*) next to the designated line. If you currently have a DFSID number, provide the number on this form. On the next lines enter your name, home address, city, state, and zip code. Please supply your telephone numbers and email so that we may reach you if we receive undelivered mail or need to reach you during the day. Additionally, provide your date of birth in order for staff to determine your age upon issuance of your certification. Provide a copy of your drivers license or birth certificate to prove your age.

If you hold a valid NJ Uniform Construction Code (UCC) license, please supply your UCC six digit license number (Example: 001234) so that the Division of Fire Safety may credit reciprocal seminars to your license.

The educational program requirements to obtain certification as a Fire Inspector or Fire Official are specified pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:71-4.9 (f) and N.J.A.C. 5:71-4.9(g) respectively, and must be the adopted programs approved through the Office of Training and Certification. Please check only one title on the application form. However, if you have successfully completed both instructional programs, and passed either the Division of Fire Safety (DFS) Fire Inspector or International Code Council (ICC) Fire Inspector 1 written exam, you may apply for both certifications at the same time and only pay one \$91.00 fee. This option would certify you to the higher Fire Official certification level. Please attach documentation which indicates your compliance to the certification criteria.

Please note that **N.J.A.C.** 5:71-4.4(b)1 establishes that "Only an education program completed within the three years prior to, or at the time of, application shall be accepted toward fulfilling the requirements for certification." Any instructional programs/written exams completed outside of the three year limit will not be accepted to meet credentialing requirements.

To obtain a *Fire Inspector* certification the State adopted credentialing program and successful passing of either the Division of Fire Safety (DFS) Fire Inspector or International Code Council (ICC) Fire Inspector 1 written exam must be completed.

To obtain a *Fire Official* certification, in addition to meeting the credentialing requirements of Fire Inspector, the State adopted Fire Official program of instruction must be completed and the individual must successfully pass the Fire Official State written exam. Please attach a photo copy of the program completion certificate(s) or official college transcript with your application.
