SPECIAL STUDY**

Purpose: The purpose of this special study is to document the use of Automatic External Defibrillators (AED) by fire departments. The Division of Fire Safety is requesting that every fire department using NFIRS 5.0, that has received an AED, create this special study in their NFIRS software using the format shown below. Please contact your software vendor if you need assistance.

Special Study ID/Code: 7000 AED

AED Values:

1. Used on civilian(s) – effective
2. Used on civilian(s) – not effective
3. Used on firefighter(s) – effective
4. Used on firefighter(s) – not effective

Please choose only **one value** per special study code. In cases where the AED was used on a civilian(s) and a firefighter(s), please select the most critical value for the special study.

Civilians include police officers and EMTs (non-fire department).

NOTE: This special study can be used along with the Thermal Imaging Camera Special Study.

EXAMPLE:

Code: 6000 Value: 5 (Used to conduct primary search/victims found)

Code: 7000 Value: 1 (Used on civilian(s) – effective)
