AMENDMENT TO THE HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION AND RAPID RE-HOUSING PROGRAM

The State of New Jersey is proposing the following amendment to its Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-housing (HPRP) Program description. The amendment expands eligible applicants to include local and county governments that receive a direct allocation of HPRP funds from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development.

ELIGIBLE SUB-GRANTEES

- Local and county governments, including HPRP entitlement areas and nonentitlement areas. Entitlement areas include: Atlantic City, Atlantic County, Bayonne, Bergen County, Burlington County, Camden, Camden County, Clifton, East Orange, Elizabeth, Essex County, Gloucester County, Hudson County, Jersey City, Middlesex County, Monmouth County, Morris County, Newark, Paterson, Somerset County, Trenton, Union City and Union County.
- Nonprofits servicing HPRP entitlement areas and non-entitlement areas.

All applicants will be required to provide a certification from their local Continuum of Care certifying that the program is consistent with the local homeless prevention plan.
