**For the 2016-2018 Lead Safe Home Remediation (LSHR) Pilot Grant from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.**

Greater Bergen Community Action (GBCA) is seeking qualifications from Lead Remediation Contractor's to be one of five contracted lead remediation contractors for residential properties within Bergen County, city of Paterson, and city of Passaic. Contractors will be contracted to complete all LSHR projects for the 2016-2018 Lead Safe Home Remediation Pilot Grant from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (DCA).
