

Year 2000 Budget Cap Exemption

In November 1998, the Local Finance Board approved a resolution creating a one year cap exemption for municipal expenses related to ensuring computer based systems can manage the Year 2000 issue.

Specifically, the Board has approved appropriations for the "purpose of testing micro-processor based equipment and computer software and for the remediation or replacement of micro-processor based equipment and computer software that is found to fail testing for Year 2000 readiness."

The Board resolution also requires that the Chief Financial Office in each municipality that uses the exception (to be shown on Sheet 20 of the budget form and titled "Y2K Readiness") certify that the purpose of the appropriation is limited to the purpose described above. The certification is also to include a schedule itemizing the <u>planned</u> allocation of the appropriation. This is to assist the Director in summarizing appropriations on a state-wide basis. Another certification will be required next year to report final expenditures.

For calendar year municipalities, the exception is valid for 1999's budget. State fiscal year municipalities have several choices. If the budget has not been adopted at this time, it may be amended to include an appropriation for Fiscal 1999. If the SFY budget has been adopted, Y2K expenditures (along with the certification) may be appropriated under emergency resolution procedures and funded outside the cap in SFY 2000. Otherwise, the exception may be used in SFY 2000.
