A motion was made by Mr. Light and second by Mr. Mapp to find a violation and to assess a fine in the amount of \$150. for each provision for a total amount of \$600. against the accused for violations of provisions N.J.S.A. 40A:9-22.5 (a), (d), (e), and (g). A roll call was taken: 6 affirmative, 2 absent (Mr. Avery and Mr. Close). Motion passed.

Concerning the matter of III.A.3. A motion was made by Ms. Rodriguez and second by Mr. Light to transmit the matter to the Office of Administrative Law as a contested case. A roll call was taken: 6 affirmative, 2 absent (Mr. Avery and Mr. Close). Motion passed.

At 9:22 am, a motion was made by Mr. Blee and second by Ms. Rodriguez to go into closed session for the purpose of discussing complaints and to receive related legal advice. A voice vote was taken. Motion passed.

At 9:31 am, a motion was made by Mr. Mapp and second by Mr. Blee to go into open session. A voice vote was taken. Motion passed.
