A roll call was taken: 6 affirmative. Motion passed.

Concerning the matter of III.B.3. A motion was made by Mr. Mapp, second by Mr. Avery to issue a Notice of Determination to one local government officer where the Board is dismissing the claims for a lack of reasonable factual basis. A roll call was taken: 6 affirmative. Motion passed.

Concerning the matter of III.B.4. A motion was made by Mr. Mapp and second by Ms. Rodriguez to issue a Notice of Determination to one local government officer where the Board is dismissing the claims for a lack of reasonable factual basis. A roll call was taken: 6 affirmative. Motion passed.

Concerning the matter of III.B.5. A motion was made by Mr. Close, second by Mr. Mapp to

issue a Notice of Dismissal to one local government officer dismissing the claim and a Notice of Violation to one local government officer for two violations of N.J.S.A. 40A:9-22.5(c) and two violations of N.J.S.A. 40A:9-22.5(g) and to assess a fine in a total amount of \$2,000 for the violations. A roll call was taken: 6 affirmative. Motion passed.
