Concerning the Matter of B.3. A motion was made by Ms. Rodriguez and second by Mr. Avery to issue a Notice of Dismissal to one (1) LGO dismissing the complaint following an investigation. A roll call was taken: 5 affirmatives. Motion passed.

Concerning the Matter of B.4. A motion was made by Mr. Avery and second by Ms. Rodriguez to rescind the Notice of Violation issued to five (5) individuals due to roster errors and to waive the fines for eleven (11) individuals who had requested an administrative hearing following the receipt of a Notice of Violation for failing to timely file the 2024 Financial Disclosure Statement. A roll call was taken: 5 affirmatives. Motion passed.

At 1:25 p.m., a motion was made by Mr. Jackson and second by Mr. Avery to go into closed session for the purpose of discussing complaints, requests for advisory opinions, and to receive related legal advice. A roll call vote was taken: 5 affirmatives. Motion passed.
