Eligibility



- Property is identified by FEMA as either:
 - ♦ Severe Repetitive Loss (SRL)
 - ♦ Four or more flood insurance claims over \$5,000, or
 - ♦ Two or more flood insurance claims exceeding the home's value.

OR

- ♦ Repetitive Loss (RL)
 - ♦ Two or more claims equal to 25% of home's value, and
 - Increased Cost of Compliance (ICC) included in National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) coverage policy.




