Reporting to the Director of Data Center Administration, the Microsoft Dynamics 365 Portal Developer will be responsible for the design, development, and maintenance of Dynamics 365 portals for the Division of Housing and Community Resources (DHCR) within the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs. These portals will support a range of programs, including lead abatement and housing services, and are essential in delivering seamless user experiences and access to program services.

The Microsoft Dynamics 365 Portal Developer will work closely with program managers and stakeholders to understand business needs and translate them into efficient and effective portal solutions. This includes customizing web forms, integrating data from Dynamics 365 CRM, and ensuring that all portals comply with security, accessibility, and regulatory requirements.
