Proclamation

WHEREAS, as our children will one day inherit our society, it is of utmost importance that they receive the nurturing and guidance that will allow them to develop to their fullest potential and lead healthy and fulfilling lives; and

WHEREAS, adopting a child is a truly noble gesture that represents an enormous amount of concern and compassion on the part of the adopting parent or parents, who have chosen a recipient for their love and protection; and

WHEREAS, the happiness and joy of adoption can result in persons of different backgrounds coming together in a family unit; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey recognizes the importance and contributions of all parents who have made the decision to open their hearts and homes to a child in need, especially those who have adopted adolescents, siblings and children with special needs; and

WHEREAS, to help these children find permanent, nurturing families, and recognizing that Saturday, November 17, 2012 is National Adoption Day;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRIS CHRISTIE, Governor of the State of New Jersey, do hereby proclaim:
