AWARD INFORMATION

Incorporation: In addition to the federal laws, regulations, policies, and CDC General Terms and Conditions for Non-research awards at <https://www.cdc.gov/grants/federal-regulations-policies/index.html> , the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) hereby incorporates Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) number **CDC-RFA-DP-23-0006**, entitled **The Sudden Unexpected Infant Death (SUID) and Sudden Death in the Young (SDY) Case Registry**, an application dated April 6, 2026, as may be amended, which are hereby made a part of this Non-research award, hereinafter referred to as the Notice of Award (NoA).

Approved Component/Project Funding: The NOFO provides for the funding of multiple components under this award. For this NOA, the approved funding level for each component is shown below:

The federal award amount is subject to adjustment based on total allowable costs incurred and/or the value of any third-party in-kind contribution when applicable.

Financial Assistance Mechanism: Cooperative Agreement.

Technical Review: Within 5 days of this Notice of Award's (NOA) issue date, the Technical Review will be accessible to the recipient in GrantSolutions Grant Notes. Contact the assigned Program Officer indicated in the NOA with any questions regarding this document or any follow up requirements and timelines set forth therein.

Substantial Involvement by CDC: This is a cooperative agreement, and CDC will have substantial programmatic involvement after the award is made. Substantial involvement is in addition to all post-award monitoring, technical assistance, and performance reviews undertaken in the normal course of stewardship of federal funds.

CDC program staff will assist, coordinate, or participate in carrying out effort under the award, and recipients agree to the responsibilities therein, as detailed in the NOFO and included below.

- CDC program staff will ensure the success of the cooperative agreement by fully supporting recipients in implementing the award, meeting the identified benchmarks, and achieving outcomes.
- **Technical assistance** will be provided for all Components in the form of training opportunities, learning collaboratives, expert presentations, and participation in the annual reverse site visit. Additional support for child death review specific needs will be garnered through a contract with the National Center for Fatality Review and Prevention. Technical assistance will include peer-to-peer learning opportunities and other learning opportunities such as attending and/or presenting at national and international conferences, meetings and other workshops.
- **Additional support for Components A and B** will include quarterly CDC-generated data reports on progress towards meeting the benchmarks in the strategies and activities section and quarterly feedback on case categorization. These reports will be sent to recipients via email at the end of each quarter and will be discussed on the monthly call following receipt of the document. CDC will also review and provide feedback on the recipients annual evaluation plan update to ensure progress towards short and intermediate outcomes.

- **Additional support for Component C** will include specific quarterly progress meetings and specialized training opportunities on community participatory activities and promising practices in prevention. CDC can also facilitate connections to partners involved in community-based research.

Budget Revision Requirement: By **October 30, 2026** the recipient must submit a revised budget with a narrative justification. Failure to submit the required information in a timely manner may adversely affect the future funding of this project. If the information cannot be provided by the due date, you are required to contact the GMS/GMO identified in the CDC Staff Contacts section of this notice before the due date.

Expanded Authority: The recipient is permitted the following expanded authority in the administration of the award.

☒ Carryover of unobligated balances from one budget period to a subsequent budget period. Unobligated funds may be used for purposes within the scope of the project as originally approved. Recipients will report use, or intended use, of unobligated funds in Section 12 “Remarks” of the annual Federal Financial Report. FUNDING RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITATIONS

Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) Restrictions:

- Recipients may not use funds for research.
- Recipients may not use funds for clinical care except as allowed by law.
- Recipients may use funds only for reasonable program purposes, including personnel, travel, supplies, and services.
- Generally, recipients may not use funds to purchase furniture or equipment. Any such proposed spending must be clearly identified in the budget.
- Reimbursement of pre-award costs generally is not allowed, unless the CDC provides written approval to the recipient.
- Other than for normal and recognized executive-legislative relationships, no funds may be used for:
 - publicity or propaganda purposes, for the preparation, distribution, or use of any material designed to support or defeat the enactment of legislation before any legislative body
 - the salary or expenses of any grant or contract recipient, or agent acting for such recipient, related to any activity designed to influence the enactment of legislation, appropriations, regulation, administrative action, or Executive order proposed or pending before any legislative body
