1. Inadequate ventilation: The center has poor ventilation in the classroom. Children are going home sweaty on hot days.	1. At the time of the investigation, adequate ventilation was maintained throughout the center and no classroom was excessively hot. Interviews with the director and staff revealed that during the month of May the air conditioner in room 1 was inoperable and adequate ventilation was not maintained. Furthermore, children in room 1 were excessively warm during this time period and only recently did the center rectify the issue and provide additional fans for room 1. The center needs to ensure that adequate ventilation is maintained at all times.	<b><u>1. Substantiated</u></b>
2. The center is not meeting the needs of the child: Children do not receive enough fluids on hot days. Children are going home dehydrated.	2. At the time of the investigation, the needs of the children were met in all classrooms and no child appeared thirsty. Interviews with the director and staff denied the allegations and indicated that children are provided with fluids regularly throughout the day and as needed and they did not know of any incident when a child became dehydrated while in their care. As a result of observation and interview, this allegation could not be substantiated.	<b><u>2. Unsubstantiated</u></b>
3. Unsafe conditions: The center has a broken outdoor playhouse that children play on.	3. At the time of the investigation, safe conditions were maintained throughout the center, including on the playground. Although one decorative shutter was missing from the outdoor playhouse, the structure itself was not broken or unsafe in any way. Interviews with the director and staff indicated that all broken toys and equipment are immediately removed from the playground once	<b><u>3. Unsubstantiated</u></b>
