<p>1. Unsanitary Conditions:</p> <p>A) Five months ago, the daycare may have been infested with roaches and fungi.</p> <p>B) A named child's clothing had mold on them.</p>	<p>1. At the time of the investigation, sanitary conditions were maintained throughout the center and there was no evidence of any infestation or mold-like substances present. Interviews with the director designee and staff denied the allegation and indicated that the center has never had an infestation of any kind, and no staff have observed mold-like substances in the center at any time, including on the named child who is no longer enrolled in the program. Additionally, staff indicated that the center is serviced regularly by an extermination service, and sanitary conditions are maintained at all times. As a result of observation and interview, this allegation could not be substantiated.</p>	1.Unsubstantiated
<p>2. Inadequate ventilation: The center has a lot of humidity and it may be causing children to become ill.</p>	<p>2. At the time of the investigation, adequate ventilation was provided throughout the center. Interviews with the director designee and staff denied that the center is ever humid or that adequate ventilation is not maintained. Further interviews with the director and staff indicated that adequate ventilation is maintained at all times. As a result of observation and interviews this allegation could not be substantiated.</p>	2.Unsubstantiated
