<p>1. Inadequate ventilation: The center may not have adequate ventilation on hot days as a named infant was perspiring at pick up.</p>	<p>1. At the time of the investigation adequate ventilation was provided throughout the center. The center was maintained at a comfortable temperature and no child appeared too hot or perspired. Interviews with the director and staff indicated that the temperature in the center does not ever exceed comfort levels and adequate ventilation is maintained at all times throughout the day, including at pick up time. As a result of observation and interview, this allegation could not be substantiated.</p>	<p><b><u>1. Unsubstantiated</u></b></p>
<p>2. Inadequate nutritional requirements: The center may not be providing adequate water to a named infant throughout the day.</p>	<p>2. At the time of the investigation, adequate nutritional requirements were maintained in all classrooms, including in the infant room. Children were provided with adequate water, bottles, food and beverages in accordance with their feeding plans and as needed. Interviews with the director and staff indicated that staff attend to all of the infant’s needs throughout the day, offering children their bottles and sippy cups on demand and as needed. As a result of observation and interview, this allegation could not be substantiated.</p>	<p><b><u>2. Unsubstantiated</u></b></p>
