Dear Resource Parent(s),

The Department of Children and Families (DCF) recently issued guidance and notification regarding the requirement for resource parents/families to receive approval from DCF's Division of Child Protection and Permanency (CP&P) **prior** to scheduling a COVID-19 vaccination for youth ages 16-18. With this letter, DCF is updating its guidance to include COVID-19 vaccinations for children ages 12-15, in response to the US Food and Drug Administration's May 10 determination to expand the emergency use of Pfizer-BioNTech for this population.

As a reminder, if a minor youth, age 12 or older, in CP&P care and custody requests to obtain the COVID-19, CP&P will attempt to obtain consent from the youth's parent(s) or, potentially notice the court and all counsel to obtain the necessary approvals.
