Dear Resource Parent(s),

The Department of Children and Families (DCF) has previously issued guidance and notification regarding the requirement for resource caregivers to receive approval from DCF's Division of Child Protection and Permanency (CP&P) **prior** to scheduling a COVID-19 vaccination for youth ages 5 or older. This letter is to notify you that DCF is now updating this requirement guidance to include COVID-19 vaccinations for children ages 6 months and older, in response to the US Food and Drug Administration as well as the Center for Disease Control's recent determination to expand the emergency use of Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna for this population.

As a reminder, if any minor youth in CP&P care and custody requests to obtain the COVID-19, CP&P will attempt to obtain consent from the youth's parent(s) or, potentially notice the court and all counsel to obtain the necessary approvals.
