### WHEN TO USE IT

Complete this form in NJ SPIRIT. The Visitation Plan is completed for all children in out-of-home placement, even when there is a court order prohibiting or limiting visitation or other circumstances warrant visitation suspension. See [CP&P-IV-A-5-100](#). The Visitation Plan is used to document:

- The visitation plan for the first visit between the child and his or her parent(s)/caregiver(s);
- The visitation plan for ongoing visits between the child and his or her parent(s)/caregiver(s), siblings, and other relatives;
- The renegotiated visitation plan between the child and his or her parent(s)/caregiver(s), siblings and other relatives;
- Any change or reduction in the frequency or duration of visits approved by the Supervisor

### HOW TO USE IT

Complete the form in the NJS Case Plan window by accessing the form through NJ SPIRIT desktop > Create Case Work > Case Planning/Family Assessment > Case Plan > Visitation Plan Tab > Options Drop-down.
