

CSOC SERVICE LINE CERTIFICATION

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW FAMILY SUPPORT PARTNER (FSP)

NOTE: Service line certifications for the NJ Children's System of Care (CSOC) apply specifically to the service lines with which they are associated: Behavioral Assistance (BA), Care Management Organization (CMO), Family Support Organization (FSO), or Mobile Response & Stabilization Services (MRSS). Certifications are valid only in New Jersey and are not transferrable to any other state.

FSO Family Support Partner (FSP) Certification Requirements

NJ Children's System of Care (CSOC) Certifications are completed through the <u>CSOC TTA Learning Management Portal (LMP)</u>. To be certified as a Family Support Partner (FSP) in NJ CSOC, **you must be hired by a Family Support Organization (FSO)**. The following certification requirements must be completed within one year of your date of hire.

First-year FSP certification includes four steps:

- 1. Complete Training through Rutgers UBHC and New Jersey Alliance of FSOs (NJAFSO).
- 2. Family Assessment of Needs & Strengths (FANS) Certification completed on TCOMTraining.com.
- 3. Competency Verification by your supervisor.
- 4. Complete the Certification Test.
