The goal is to create a safe, stable, and therapeutically supportive environment with a comprehensive array of services that will assist the youth with acquiring, retaining, improving and generalizing the behavioral, self- help, socialization, and communication skills needed to increase independence (e.g. improving self-care), regulate emotional and behavioral responses, increase participation; develop meaningful relationships, and effectively understand and express their needs to the best of their ability that will aid in the successful transition back to their home and community.

Opportunities are “forecasted” when funds are not yet formally available and are pending budgetary and discretionary spending approvals and federal agency program decisions. Once the forecasted opportunities are made final as a viable funding announcement, you will be able to complete and apply for consideration of funding within the timeframe of the Request for Proposal deadline date for any funding announcement you desire.
