POTENTIAL FOUR (4) FIVE BED PROGRAM (20 Beds)

Psychiatric Community Home (PCH) services are designed to provide community-based treatment to youth whose DSM 5 diagnosis indicates that they are in need of acute care. The requested PCH treatment services are comprehensive, multidisciplinary, multimodal therapies that are designed to meet the individual needs of youth who have psychiatric disorders.

Opportunities are “forecasted” when funds are not yet formally available and are pending budgetary and discretionary spending approvals and federal agency program decisions. Once the forecasted opportunities are made final as a viable funding announcement, you will be able to complete and apply for consideration of funding within the timeframe of the Request for Proposal deadline date for any funding announcement you desire.
