

Creamer Cap Critters

Materials:

- 1 - Washed & dried coffee creamer cap – From Coffee-mate, International Delight, Store Brand, and most others
- 2 - Washed & dried empty individual serving size fruit bowls, hummus, applesauce, etc. plastic containers.
- Bottle caps, buttons, toothpaste caps, etc. for eyes
- Scissors
- Hot glue & glue gun
- Old file folders, cereal box cardboard, heavy weight paper etc. to use to make a heart.
- Optional: coffee stirrers or pipe cleaners for arms

Note: Hot glue will work just fine. For longer durability, a glue such as epoxy will hold the materials together better.

However, epoxy should not be used inside in the winter. Other plastic glues (such as tacky glue, gorilla glue, etc.) may work but have not been tested. Always check to see if a glue can be used indoors.

Directions:

- Glue the wide opening of one plastic fruit bowl to the wide opening of the other.
- Cut the bottom out of one of the plastic fruit bowls. Don't cut too much. The creamer cap should cover this hole.
- Glue the creamer cap over the fruit bowl with the cut out top so that it covers the hole.
- Glue bottle caps, buttons, etc, together to make two "eyes"
- Glue the eyes to the top of the creamer cap.
- Cut out a heart from heavy weight paper, cardboard, etc. Glue to the body of the creamer cap critter where desired.
- Fill critter with M&Ms, skittles, nuts, etc. and give as a Valentine's Day gift!

Optional: Use recycled coffee stirrers or pipe cleaners to make arms for your creamer cap critter. Position and glue to the body where desired.
