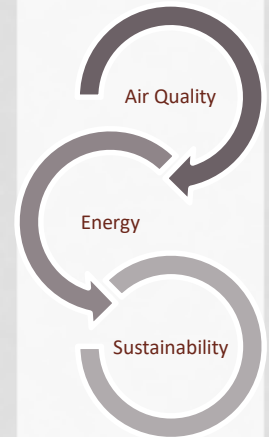

AIR PROGRAM FEE CHANGES

ANNUAL EMISSION FEE, AIR PERMITS, AND
RECONSTRUCTION THRESHOLD AMOUNT

WHAT'S CHANGING

1. Annual Emission Fees

- Paid by Major Air Facilities
- CPI Adjustment: 1.9% Increase over FY2019
- FY2020 Fee: \$124.77 per ton of emissions
- Based on Emission Statements submitted in 2019
- Emission Fee Invoices to Facilities by Dec 31, 2019
- Fee Due by Jan 31, 2020

WHAT'S CHANGING

2. Air Permit Fees

- Major and Minor Air Facilities
- Minor Facilities: GP, PCP Base and Supplementary Fees
- Major Facilities: GOP, Significant Modifications - Base and Supplementary Fees. No change in \$50,000 cap
- CPI Adjustment: 7.9% change over preceding 5-year period

WHAT'S CHANGING

2. Threshold Dollar Amount for Reconstruction

- Minor and Major Facilities
- Used for Calculating Reconstruction Thresholds relative to Fixed Capital Cost
- CPI Adjustment: 1.9% Increase over FY2019
- FY2020 Threshold dollar amount \$134,512

- NJ Register Notice Publication on Nov 4, 2019
- Listserv expected shortly
- All New Fees, effective Jan 1, 2020
- Current rules remain Unchanged until the Effective Date
