(d) Exemptions

Even if a source is listed in (c) above, any of the following is not a significant source (and therefore does not need a preconstruction permit and operating certificate) if it is:









What has been done already?

(e & f) Insignificant Sources

Equipment or a source operation, which would be classified as a significant source solely because it meets the criteria in (c)19 above, is not a significant source (and therefore does not need a permit and certificate), provided that (e)1, 2 and 3 below are satisfied:
