

**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT
ON AN AIR POLLUTION CONTROL PRECONSTRUCTION PERMIT**

Facility: Cumberland County Recycling Center

The New Jersey State Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) is seeking public comment on its intent to approve an Air Pollution Control Preconstruction Permit for Cumberland County Recycling Center pursuant to the provisions of Air Pollution Control Act of Chapter 106, P.L. 1967 (N.J.S.A. 26:2C-1 et. seq.) and state regulation promulgated at N.J.A.C. 7:27-8. These rules require that any significant source of air contaminant emissions must obtain a preconstruction permit prior to construction, reconstruction, installation, or modification.

FACILITY INFORMATION

Cumberland County Recycling Center plans to install and operate a new indoor co-composting facility processing biosolids. All air emissions from the indoor composting operation are to be routed to and controlled by a biofilter. The proposed composting air contaminant emissions are based on emission factors taken from a study performed by the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District. The facility will monitor and record temperature, pH, moisture content, and pressure drop to ensure that the biofilter is operating according to its manufacturer specifications. The address of the facility is 745 Lebanon Rd, Deerfield Twp, NJ 08332, Cumberland County. The equipment covered by this draft permit includes: one (1) indoor composting facility, one (1) outdoor amendment storage area, one (1) outdoor finished product storage area, and one (1) screener.

All persons, including the applicant, who believe that any condition of the draft preconstruction permit or the Department's tentative decision to approve this permit is inappropriate, must raise all reasonable issues of concern and submit all arguments and factual grounds or materials supporting their position during the public comment period. Any comments on this draft permit must be received within sixty days of the date of this notice and addressed to Quddus Qayyum, Bureau of Stationary Sources, New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, 401 E State Street, 2nd Floor, PO Box 420, Mail Code 401-02, Trenton, New Jersey 08625-0420.

Any person may request that the Department hold a public hearing on the draft permit. A request for a public hearing shall be submitted, in writing, within sixty days of the date of this notice to

the Department at the Trenton address listed above. The request for public hearing shall include a statement of issues to be discussed at the public hearing. The statement of issues shall be relevant to the draft permit under review by the Department.
