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## Permit Descriptions

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**CAFRA** - A Coastal Area Facility Act permit is required to construct residential, commercial, public, transportation, utility and energy-related facilities in the coastal area as defined by the Act.

**Federal Consistency Activity:** Certain federal permits, not limited to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Dredge and Fill Permits, require certification by the DEP prior to the issuance of the permit by the federal agency.

**Flood Hazard Area:** A Flood Hazard permit or verification is required for disturbances within the floodway or floodplain in areas regulated under the Flood Hazard Area Control Act.

**Freshwater Wetlands:** A Permit (Letters of Exemption, Letters of Interpretation, Statewide General Permit, Open Water Fill, Individual, Transition Area Waiver, Water Quality Certificate) is needed prior to engaging in a regulated activity in or around freshwater wetlands and associated transition areas. A Flood Hazard Area Permit, an U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Dredge and Fill Permit, and a Water Quality Certification may also be required.

**General Groundwater Petroleum Products Cleanup:** This general permit authorizes the surface water discharge of treated groundwater previously contaminated with petroleum products.

**NJPDES permits:** A permit is required for the discharge of pollutants to surface and groundwater, a discharge from an indirect user or the land application of municipal and/or industrial residuals. (A more comprehensive definition of activities, which require a permit, may be found at N.J.A.C. 7:14A-2.4)

**Solid Waste Facility:** A permit is required to conduct or operate any solid waste facility as defined under the Solid Waste Management Act, N.J.S.A. 13:1E-1 et seq., and N.J.A.C. 7:26-1 et seq.

**Highlands Resource:** A Highland Preservation Area Approval is required for regulated activities within the Highland Preservation Area as defined in the Highlands Water Protection & Planning Act Preservation Area Rules. Highlands Applicability Determinations verifies certain exemptions allowed by the regulations.

**Tidal Wetlands:** A Coastal Wetlands Permit is needed to excavate, dredge, fill or erect structures on coastal wetlands.

**Treatment Works Approval:** A TWA permit is required for the construction, modification or operation of a treatment works, including sanitary/industrial sewage pretreatment or treatment systems, sewage conveyance systems, sewer extensions and subsurface sewage disposal systems.

**Waterfront Development:** A permit is required for any project involving the development of waterfront near or upon any tidal or navigable waterway in the State.

**Coastal Wetlands:** A permit authorizing disturbances to Mapped Tidal Wetlands under the Wetlands Act of 1970, N.J.S.A. 13:9A”

## General Information

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The DEP Bulletin is an information service provided by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection. In addition, this publication lists status of Highlands application and Highlands Applicability Determinations.

In addition, a calendar of Events of Interest and a Schedule of Public Hearings is provided. The public hearings listed do not, however, constitute an official notice. Environmental Impact Statements acted upon during the period are also shown. Additional information concerning the permit applications can be obtained by calling the project manager at the appropriate office listed on the inside back cover.

Public Hearings are held for the purpose of obtaining input and reaction to a proposed rule, regulation, or new program. Some hearings may be mandated by law. Generally their scope of impact is statewide or of broad general interest and open to the public.

Contested Case Hearings are held between the State and a particular party involving an application, enforcement violation or an appeal. Interest in these hearings is generally limited to those directly involved.

DEP Events of Public Interest include public hearings, council meetings, workshops, public information meetings, and exams.

FRESHWATER WETLANDS LETTER OF INTERPRETATION**

**TAKE NOTICE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION** intends to enter into a Settlement Agreement that would partially modify determined jurisdictional areas under the Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act rules. The Department has agreed to a change in approach to determining extent of wetlands/waters and corresponding mapping revisions made to “Tract I”, also known as Block 1902; Lots 37 and 47, after further field assessments and submittal of well data. Tract I is a small portion of lands covered by the Letter of Interpretation. All other Blocks and Lots within the Letter of Interpretation are not changed from the original Letter of Interpretation and approved plans until and unless the Letter of Interpretation is further modified during its 5 year lifespan. The settlement agreement is in accordance with the Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act Rules (N.J.A.C. 7:7A-1 et seq.).

**Notice Regarding Adoption of Site Specific Water Quality Management Plan Amendment  
Applications Pursuant to P.L.2013, c.188**

Notice is hereby given that the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), Office of Coastal and Land Use Planning, has adopted the following Water Quality Management Plan site specific amendment requests pursuant to P.L. 2013, c.188 which was enacted on January 15, 2014. This legislation modifies some aspects of the Water Quality Management Planning Program for a period of two years. P.L. 2013, c.188 directs the Department to accept and process certain site specific amendment proposals despite the absence of a wastewater management plan in compliance with the Water Quality Management Plan rules. Pursuant to the provisions of the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), notices of amendment proposals and the Department’s subsequent final action are to be published in the New

Jersey Register (NJR). In accordance with P.L. 2013, c.188, notice of adoption of site specific amendments for projects or activities having a wastewater planning flow of less than 50,000 gallons per day (gpd) or being less than 100 acres in size is to be published in the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Bulletin.

Fiddlers Elbow County Club**

**Take notice** that on **August 11, 2014** pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15, an amendment to the Upper Raritan Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department). This amendment modifies the Somerset County/Upper Raritan Watershed Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) and the Somerset County-wide Map, Future Wastewater Service Area, to provide for the expansion the existing Fiddlers Elbow County Club (FECC), located on Block 37.01, Lots 1 and 1.01, Bedminster Township, Somerset County. The proposed expansion of the existing golf club is to include the construction of 2 cottages, an expanded member's clubhouse and restaurant seating, a pool complex, Golf and Tennis Pro Shops, a Golf Academy, and Cart Barn. As part of this proposed amendment, the current Somerset County/Upper Raritan WMP Facility Table 6 for the FECC on-site Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) (NJPDES #NJ0021865) is proposed to be modified to indicate that the combined existing flow, and new projected wastewater flow from the proposed expansion, of the FECC to be discharged to surface water is within the current permitted maximum flow value of 0.030 million gallons per day (mgd).

This proposed amendment has been reviewed in accordance with the Water Quality Management Planning rules at N.J.A.C. 7:15 and P.L. 2011, c.203, amended and supplemented by P.L. 2013, c. 188. This preliminary notice represents the Department's determination that the proposed amendment is in compliance with the regulatory criteria.

To accommodate the expanded and new facilities, this proposed amendment would provide for an adjustment of the existing approved sewer service area of the FECC STP to contain only the existing and proposed new wastewater generating structures, including the proposed two guest cottages, the pool house, and exercise area, Golf and Tennis Pro Shops, Golf Academy and Cart Barn.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b), environmentally sensitive areas have been assessed to determine what areas are appropriately included in the proposed sewer service area. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, environmentally sensitive areas are defined as contiguous areas of 25 acres or larger, alone or in combination, consisting of habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species (Landscape Project), Natural Heritage Priority Sites, Category One (C1) special water resource protection areas, and wetlands. These environmentally sensitive areas are not included in the proposed sewer service area except as noted below.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)1, to determine areas designated as threatened or endangered species habitat, the Department utilized the Landscape Project, version 3.1. A review of the Landscape Project indicated that the project location is identified as threatened and endangered species habitat for the

Bobolink. However, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.26, a habitat suitability determination was performed by the Department which found that the current conditions at this project location are not suitable for this grassland bird species.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)2 through 4, (c), and (d), no portion of the proposed SSA for the development on site is identified as within a Natural Heritage Priority Site, a special water resource protection area along a Category One water, wetlands or associated buffer, coastal planning area, coastal resource, or an environmentally sensitive area limited by Federal 201 grant restrictions.

The FECC is currently served by an on-site Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) (NJPDES #NJ0021865). That NJPDES permit, reissued by the Department in October 1, 2004, indicates a three-day maximum wastewater flow value of 0.030 mgd. At the time, this figure was based upon a design flow criteria pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:14A-23.3 that applies 35 gallons per day (gpd) per capita use of facilities at non-residential clubs. Employing this standard, the design wastewater flow for the FECC STP was projected to account for 225 patrons for the clubhouse dining seating, 28 employees attributed to a maintenance building, plus a maximum of 600 golfers per day, yielding a total of 853 persons utilizing the club facilities on an average peak weekend. The design flow of for a three day peak, therefore, was calculated to be (35 gpd x 853) 29,855 gpd. This volume was rounded to 30,000 gpd and applied to develop the effluent limitations in the issued NJPDES permit.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)1, a build-out analysis was conducted to identify future projected flow for all new proposed wastewater generating structures and/or activities that would result due to the expansion at the FECC. The proposed new development at the FECC will consist of an expanded existing club house to increase the dining by 125 seats to accommodate up to 350 members and guests, two guest cottages, a swimming pool area and exercise room, a 5,100 square foot (sq. ft.) Golf and Tennis Pro Shop, a 1,122 sq. ft. Golf Academy, and an expanded maintenance staff from 28 to 40. Application of the appropriate criteria at N.J.A.C. 7:14A-23.3 for these various new wastewater generating activities results in a projected wastewater flow of 9,397 gpd.

In addition, due to the anticipated increase in member use resulting from the expanded recreational and eating facilities, the future rounds of golf at the course was projected to increase by 450 rounds. As part of the proposed project, FECC has indicated that at the current membership golf outings yielded an average maximum peak of approximately 150 golf rounds.

As more recent data regarding wastewater generated by golf course activity has become available, the Department now applies more appropriate projected flow of 15 gpd per golf round based on activities at recreational parks and picnic areas, as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:14A-23.3. Therefore, the flow projected from the increased 450 golf rounds is 6,750 gpd. Consequently the total projected wastewater flow as result from all expanded and new facilities and golf rounds is projected to be 16,147 gpd.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)2, an analysis was performed to assess the existing and future wastewater treatment needs for the FECC STP. The existing wastewater flow for this wastewater treatment plant was calculated based on the average of the monthly metered flow from August 2012 through July 2013 as reported to the Department in the Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) received from this STP. The existing flow from the FECC calculated for this period is 5,158 gpd. The total projected wastewater flow that would result from all expanded and new facilities and golf rounds is projected to be 16,147 gpd. The total projected wastewater flow for the existing, expanded, and new facilities and golf rounds is 21,305 gpd. Therefore, the proposed project is within the current permitted wastewater flow of 30,000 gpd to the on-site STP. As such no expansion to this STP is necessary at this time.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)3, the Department evaluated the water supply availability for the proposed project. Water for sanitary and potable purposes at the FECC is supplied by three wells located on site. Well 2 provides water for the maintenance building; Well 3 is the main well for the clubhouse; and Well 1 is a backup well for the clubhouse. Each of the three wells is permitted to withdraw approximately 50,000 gpd. To provide potable and sanitary water to the new proposed development, the project will utilize these privately owned permitted wells associated with activity conducted at the FECC parcels. As the proposed wastewater treatment system is permitted to discharge up to 30,000 gpd discharge effluent, the water supply analysis determined that the onsite water supply for the onsite wells would be sufficient to supply the future needs.

The proposed project is located within the Highlands Planning Area. In accordance N.J.A.C 7:15-3.10 the Department shall not approve a WQM Plan amendment for a project proposed in the Highlands Planning Area without first seeking comments from the Highlands Council (Council). To this end, the applicant was directed by the Department to provide the Council a copy of the proposed amendment application and all supporting documentation with a cover letter formally requesting a review of the amendment proposal and to provide the Department with recommendations, if any.

In response to the request for recommendations, the Department received correspondence from the Council dated April 14, 2014 indicating that the proposed project is located in a HUC-14 subwatershed identified in the Highlands Regional Master Plan (RMP) as having a water supply deficit. The Council calculated that the increased water demand, supplied by on-site wells, would exacerbate the deficit of net water availability as an additional consumptive use. Therefore, the Council deemed the proposed project inconsistent with policies of the RMP. To address the water supply deficit, as required by the RMP, the proposed project would need to develop a plan to mitigate the projected consumptive loss by a factor of 125%. Based on the proposed wastewater flow projections for the new facilities at the FECC, the Council calculated a mitigation target of 2,018 gpd. However, it was recommended the applicant be allowed to coordinate with the Council to determine if a more appropriate targeted mitigation value was warranted and to develop a plan to mitigate the agreed upon target. The Council suggested that the mitigation plan entail a combination of an increase in groundwater recharge and permanent water conservation techniques.

On May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2014 the Council notified the Department that to resolve the RMP inconsistency, the site design engineer for the proposed project submitted additional information, including actual discharged flow data for the previous 5 years, supporting a revised projected consumptive water demand. Consequently, the Council agreed to a new revised mitigation target of 666 gpd and to work with the engineer to prepare a mitigation plan to off-set this value.

It is noted here that the notice published on June 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, in the DEP Bulletin (Volume 38, Issue 12) incorrectly listed the mitigation target as 533 gpd, which failed to include the 125 % mitigation factor. As stated above this actual target of mitigation volume is 666 gpd,

The mitigation plan proposed by the applicant's design engineer included enhanced groundwater recharge methods beyond those required pursuant to the stormwater management regulations combined with an architectural design plan for the installation of low flow plumbing fixtures for all new proposed building structures and to retrofit 5 fixtures (toilets, urinals, and/or showers) within existing buildings with new higher-efficiency components to offset the consumptive use.

Subsequently, the applicant proposed a revised architectural design plan for municipal approval for the replacement of the five existing 5 toilets with high efficiency water use fixtures, and documented that additional increased groundwater recharge was previously approved as part of the on-site stormwater management design plans. On May 8, 2014, the applicant submitted to the Council a copy of the Toilet

Replacement Plan, prepared by JGA Architectural Design. As a result, in a letter dated May 19, 2014 the Council advised the Department that these actions satisfied the mitigation requirement and deemed the proposed project in compliance and consistent with the RMP.

To demonstrate compliance with non-point source pollution control pursuant to N.J.A.C 7:15-5.25(h)4, the Department confirmed that the Township of Bedminster Somerset County, New Jersey has adopted a stormwater control ordinance (Ord. #05-40, §2) in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:8. Therefore, a review for compliance with the Stormwater Management rules is required to be conducted under the township's authority. Consequently, the requirements of N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(g)1 for stormwater control have been satisfied.

To demonstrate compliance with non-point source pollution control pursuant to N.J.A.C 7:15-5.25(h)5, the Department has confirmed that no new development is proposed within a riparian zone.

To demonstrate compliance with non-point source pollution control pursuant to N.J.A.C 7:15-5.25(h)6, the Department has confirmed that no portion of the proposed development is located within a steep slope.

Approval of this amendment does not eliminate the need for any permits, approvals or certifications required by any Federal, State, County or municipal review agency with jurisdiction over this project/activity.

**Proposed Amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan  
Public Notice  
Pinnacle Place**

**Take notice** that the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is seeking public comment on a proposed amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management (WQM) Plan. This amendment proposal, submitted on behalf of Mr. Thomas Hedenberg, President, of 530 Delsea Drive, LLC, would expand the sewer service area (SSA) of the Gloucester County Utilities Authority Wastewater Treatment Facility (GCUA WTF) to include Block 48 Lots 2, 3, 4, 13 located in Washington Township, Gloucester County. The SSA expansion would include the proposed development of 94 townhouses and two single family homes, known as the Pinnacle Place development.

This proposal would amend the GCUA Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) adopted December 10, 2008 to include the Pinnacle Place development in the GCUA WTF SSA. This application has been reviewed in accordance with the Water Quality Management Planning rules that set the environmental standards to be applied to an amendment at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.18, N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24 and N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25, as modified by P.L. 2011, c. 203 (amended by P.L. 2013, c. 188).

Pursuant to P.L. 2011, c. 203, as amended by P.L. 2013, c. 188, the Department, in consultation with the applicable wastewater management planning agency, may approve the inclusion of land within a SSA notwithstanding that existing treatment works may not currently have the assured capacity to treat wastewater from such land without infrastructure improvements or permit modification. Therefore, amendments to modify a SSA may be approved if such actions are compliant with the applicable sections of the Water Quality Management Planning rule (N.J.A.C. 7:15) regardless of whether capacity has been fully

assessed, however, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)1, the projected wastewater flow of the project has been evaluated. The proposed wastewater flow, as calculated in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:14A-23.3 is 28,800 gallons per day. Currently, GCUA WTF is permitted to discharge 27 million gallons per day (MGD) of treated wastewater to the Delaware River under NJDPES permit number NJ0024686. The average of the last twelve months of discharge monitoring data show that GCUA WTF has discharged an average daily flow of 19.273 MGD. The additional 0.029 MGD of wastewater will not cause the wastewater generation potential of the expanded SSA to exceed the permitted capacity of the GCUA WTF.

The GCUA WTF provides treatment for the northern portion of Gloucester County known as the Consolidated District. Along with Washington Township, the Consolidated District includes Clayton Borough, Deptford Township, Glassboro Borough, Mantua Township, National Park Borough, Paulsboro Borough, Pitman Borough, Wenonah Borough, West Deptford Township, Westville Borough, Woodbury City, Woodbury Heights Borough, and portions of East Greenwich, Elk, and Monroe Townships. As part of the GCUA WMP, an environmental constraints/build-out analysis was performed for these Townships in order to identify future wastewater needs. Based on the analysis, Washington Township has a projected need to treat 0.987 MGD of additional residential wastewater flow, which is not yet connected to the GCUA WTF. The additional 0.029 MGD of planned residential wastewater flow generated from this project would be added to the current planning flow of 0.987 MGD, resulting in a new residential planning flow of 1.016 MGD for Washington Township. The GCUA WMP would be updated to reflect the proposed SSA expansion.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24 and 5.25, environmentally sensitive areas (ESAs) have been assessed to determine what areas of the project are appropriate for inclusion in the proposed SSA. ESAs evaluated include, but are not limited to: habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, riparian zones, wetlands, steep slopes, Coastal Fringe, Coastal Rural and Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Planning Areas, beaches, coastal high hazard areas, and dunes.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, ESAs are defined as contiguous areas of 25 acres or larger consisting of habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, Category One (C1) special water resource protection areas, and wetlands, alone or in combination. These ESAs are not included in the proposed SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)1, to determine areas designated as threatened or endangered species habitat, the Department utilized the Division of Fish and Wildlife's Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, version 3.1. Areas identified by the Landscape Project as being suitable habitat for threatened and endangered species Ranks 3 (State threatened) , 4 (State endangered), and 5 (Federal endangered or threatened) are not to be included in proposed SSAs except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h), or unless a site has undergone a site specific Habitat Suitability Determination prepared in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.26 that found the site to be not suitable habitat, or pursuant with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(g)2, the Department determined the ESA is not critical to a population of endangered or threatened species the loss of which would decrease the likelihood of the survival or recovery of the identified species. Review of the project site has determined that no threatened or endangered species habitat exists on site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)2, areas mapped as Natural Heritage Priority Sites are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). Review of the project site has determined that no Natural Heritage Priority Sites exist on site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)5i, riparian zones shall be protected. Riparian zones or buffers are established along all surface waters, based on the surface water body's classification designated at N.J.A.C. 7:9B, under the following regulations: the Flood Hazard Area Control Act Rules, the Stormwater Management rules, and the Water Quality Management Planning rules. A Riparian zone has been identified adjacent to the project site, and the soils onsite are identified as acidic soils (lower member of the Kirkwood Formation), therefore the required riparian buffer width for the Porch Branch is 150 feet from top of bank. The applied buffer does not encroach upon the proposed SSA, therefore the Riparian Corridor Analysis is satisfied.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)4, areas mapped as wetlands pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:9A-1 and 13:9B-25 are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e)2, Letter of Interpretation, L.O.I. # 0818-06-0003.1 was submitted, which indicates the presence of wetlands on Block 52, Lot 4.01, and requires a 50 foot buffer. All though the applicant originally included Block 52, Lot 4.01 in their proposed SSA, they have subsequently removed the proposed SSA from this lot, avoiding any wetlands on the site, thereby satisfying N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)4.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)6, proposed development disturbance is not to be located in areas with steep slopes, defined as any slope greater than 20 percent. There are no steep slopes on the subject site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(c), lands within certain coastal planning areas (Coastal Fringe, Coastal Rural, and Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Planning Areas) are not included in the SSA. The project site is not in a coastal planning area.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)1, areas with Federal 201 grant limitations that prohibit the extension of sewers to serve development in specified areas such as wetlands and floodplains are excluded from proposed SSAs. There are no grant conditions for this site.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)2-4, special restricted areas such as beaches, coastal high hazard areas, and dunes are not to be included in the proposed SSA. This site does not contain these areas.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)3 the water supply need for the proposed project has been evaluated. The proposed project would be served by the public water supply provided by Washington Township, which is currently permitted under PWSID 0818004 to allocate 273 million gallons per month (MGM) and has a water supply surplus of 30.825 MGM. The proposed water demand of the project is 0.020 MGD or 0.611 MGM, which, when added to the current demand, is within the water supply surplus; therefore sufficient water supply is available to serve the proposed development within the existing water allocation permit.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)4, a project or activity's stormwater management is to be evaluated. However, P.L. 2011, c. 203 as amended by P.L. 2013, C. 188, directs there be a presumption that an engineered subdivision or site plan is not required. Compliance with this standard shall be demonstrated by submission of an adopted stormwater management plan and ordinance that conform with the requirements of N.J.A.C. 7:8. The project is in compliance with this standard, as Washington Township has adopted stormwater control ordinance #28-2006, which complies with the performance standards of the Stormwater Management Rules at N.J.A.C. 7:8. The county and local governments are responsible for review and implementation of the Stormwater Management rules during their review and approval of proposed development.

This proposed amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues may need to be addressed prior to final permit issuance. The Warren County Pequest MUA Belvidere WTF discharges under NJDPES permit number NJ0035114 and discharges to the Delaware River.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, environmentally sensitive areas (ESAs) have been assessed to determine what areas of the project are appropriate for inclusion in the proposed SSA. ESAs evaluated include, but are not limited to: habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape

Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, riparian zones, wetlands, steep slopes, Coastal Fringe, Coastal Rural and Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Planning Areas, beaches, coastal high hazard areas, and dunes.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b), ESAs are defined as contiguous areas of 25 acres or larger consisting of habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, Category One (C1) special water resource protection areas, and wetlands, alone or in combination. As determined by the Department, the property does not feature suitable habitat for endangered and threatened animal species.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)1, areas with Federal 201 grant limitations that prohibit the extension of sewers to serve development in specified areas such as wetlands and floodplains are excluded from proposed SSAs.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)1, the projected wastewater flow, is 5000 gallons per day (gpd). Currently, Warren County Pequest MUA Belvidere WTF is permitted to discharge 0.5 million gallons per day (MGD) of treated wastewater to the Delaware River. The current annual average flow is 0.26 mgd, therefore there is adequate capacity at the facility to treat the additional 5000 gpd.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)3 the water supply need for the proposed project is 5425 gallons per day. The proposed project would be served by the public water supply provided by New Jersey American Water Company which is currently permitted to allocate 28.5 million gallons per month (MGM) and has a capacity of 13.89 mgm. There is sufficient water supply available to serve the proposed development within the existing water allocation permit.

White Township has an adopted a stormwater control ordinance in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:8. Consequently, the requirements of N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)4 for stormwater control have been satisfied. No portion of the proposed development on site is identified as within a riparian zone as established at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(5) 5 or areas with a steep slope as required at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)6.

This proposed amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues may need to be addressed prior to final permit issuance. As outlined at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, sewer service may only be provided to areas that are not identified as environmentally sensitive areas (ESAs), Coastal Fringe, Coastal Rural and Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Planning Areas, beaches, coastal high hazard areas, and dunes. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, ESAs are defined as contiguous areas of 25 acres or larger consisting of habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, Category One (C1) special water resource protection areas, and wetlands, alone or in combination. Review of the proposed project site has determined that there are no ESA’s identified on the parcel.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(c), certain coastal planning areas, not applicable here, must also be excluded from SSA. Specifically, there are no Coastal Fringe Planning Areas, Coastal Rural Planning Areas, or Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Areas on the project site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)1, areas with Federal 201 grant limitations that prohibit the extension of sewers are excluded from the adopted SSA either where local mapped information exists delineating these areas, or through a narrative description where mapping does not exist, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(f)1. Where a narrative approach has been used, it is noted as text on the adopted FWSA map. Pre-existing grant conditions and requirements (from Federal and State grants or loans for sewerage facilities), which provide for restriction of sewer service to environmentally sensitive areas, are unaffected by adoption of these amendments and compliance is required.

In addition to the environmentally sensitive areas with Federal 201 grant limitations that prohibit the extension of sewers identified under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)1, there are other special restricted areas, not applicable here, which must also be excluded from SSA pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)2 through 4. Specifically, there are no beaches, coastal high hazard areas, or dunes on the project site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)1, the projected wastewater flow of the existing zoning for the above mentioned lots has been evaluated. The Department has determined that the OCUA Northern Wastewater Pollution Control Facility has adequate available capacity to treat the proposed wastewater flow from the lots should they be developed in accordance with existing zoning regulations.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)3 the water supply need for the proposed project has been evaluated. Water supply for any proposed development on the property will be provided by the Lakewood Township Municipal Utilities Authority which is a public water system. The existing water allocation permit will not require modification to serve the proposed project

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)4, a project or activity's stormwater management is to be evaluated. However, P.L. 2013, c. 188 directs that there is a presumption that an engineered subdivision or site plan is not required. Without such information a review and determination of compliance with the Stormwater Management rules (N.J.A.C. 7:8) is not possible. The county and local governments are responsible for review and implementation of the Stormwater Management rules during their review and approval of proposed development. Lakewood Township has an adopted stormwater management ordinance (No. 2006-22) which complies with the performance standards of the Stormwater Management Rules at N.J.A.C. 7:8.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 5.25(h)5, a riparian zone has been identified on the proposed project site as the property is bisected by a tributary to the Kettle Creek (FW2-NT/SE1). Riparian zones or buffers are established along all surface waters, based on the surface water body's classification designated at N.J.A.C. 7:9B, under the following regulations: the Flood Hazard Area Control Act Rules, the Stormwater Management rules, and the Water Quality Management Planning rules. The required buffer width for Crystal Creek is 50 feet. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)5i, the Riparian Corridor Analysis has been satisfied by the exclusion of the buffer area from the proposed SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)1, to determine areas designated as threatened or endangered species habitat, the Department utilized the Division of Fish and Wildlife's Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, version 3.1. Areas identified by the Landscape Project as being suitable habitat for threatened and endangered species Ranks 3 (State threatened), 4 (State endangered), and 5 (Federal endangered or threatened) are not to be included in proposed SSAs except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h), or unless a site has undergone a site specific Habitat Suitability Determination prepared in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.26 that found the site to be not suitable habitat, or pursuant with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(g)2, the Department determined the ESA is not critical to a population of endangered or threatened species the loss of which would decrease the likelihood of the survival or recovery of the identified species. Review of the proposed project site has determined while the site had previously been included in a larger area mapped as Threatened and Endangered Species Habitat by

the Landscape Project, subsequent development of adjacent properties has reduced the contiguous habitat area on the proposed project site to under 25 acres, thus removing it for consideration as an Environmentally Sensitive Area, as defined under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, to be excluded from consideration as a sewer service area

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)2, areas mapped as Natural Heritage Priority Sites are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). Review of the project site has determined that no Natural Heritage Priority Sites exist on site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)4, areas mapped as wetlands pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:9A-1 and 13:9B-25 are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) through (h). In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e)2, a Letter of Interpretation, L.O.I. #1514-05-0019.1 FWW050001, issued by the Department's Division of Land Use Regulation (DLUR) on December 8, 2005, was submitted to the Department, confirming the presence and boundaries of ordinary and intermediate resource value wetlands, requiring a 50-foot buffer. In compliance with the LOI, the proposed SSA excludes both the mapped wetlands and associated 50-foot buffer, together which amount to approximately 3 acres. This L.O.I. remains valid under the Permit Extension Act at N.J.A.C. 7:1B until June 30, 2015.
