Thank you for the New Jersey Coastal Management Program's July 10, 2024 request for approval of changes to the administration of the NJ Coastal Management Program (NJ CMP) and the incorporation of Flood Hazard Area Control Act (N.J.S.A. 58:16A-50) and Flood Hazard Area Control Act Rules pursuant to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Coastal Zone Management Act (CZMA) regulations at 15 CFR part 923, subpart H.

NOAA's Office for Coastal Management approves the request subject to the qualification below.

NOAA's regulations require that the state post this decision by the Office for Coastal Management for public notice.
