


## LEGEND

They also retain a perpetual easement over such areas as are necessary for the maintenance and operation of all railroad facilities on lands colored yellow to be conveyed to the State by quit-claim deed; such areas to extend not less than twelve feet from the center line of each track measured on the side of the base of rail, with right to maintain same cut or fill as the conditions may require.





AS OF JUNE 12, 1934.


