The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Bergen County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated January 12, 2021. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of the revised hours of operation at the National Transfer, Inc. Transfer Station/Materials Recovery Facility (TS/MRF) located at 445 North Main Street, Block 169.02, Lots 21.01 and 21.05 in the Borough of Lodi.

Specifically, the following revised hours of operation are included in the County Plan for the National Transfer, Inc. TS/MRF:

• Acceptance of waste: Monday through Friday, 6:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Saturday, 6:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Processing of waste: Monday through Friday, 6:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Saturday, 6:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11(b)14, the inclusion of revised hours of operation can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of the revised hours of operation at the National Transfer, Inc. TS/MRF is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11(f).

Please be advised that this administrative action approval shall not be construed as an expression of the Department's intent to issue a permit modification to the subject facility for the above noted operational changes.
